

**RESOLUTION 2020-004**

**BEFORE THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMAN  
OR  
THE TOWN OF BLUFF CITY, TENNESSEE**

**“A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BLUFF CITY TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS THROUGH THE MULTIMODAL ACCESS PROGRAM BY THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CONSTRUCT A SIDEWALK AND FOUR CROSSWALKS ALONG BLUFF CITY HIGHWAY TO PROVIDE FOR THE SAFETY OF PEDESTRIANS AT AN ESTIMATED TOTAL PROJECT COST OF \$745,286.50 WITH A REQUIRED 5% MATCH BEING PROVIDED BY THE TOWN OF BLUFF CITY AT A COST OF \$37,264.33.”**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Bluff City is committed to constructing sidewalks to ensure the safety of pedestrians; and

**WHEREAS**, the lack of sidewalks along Bluff City Highway (State Route 390 & 44) creates a dangerous situation for pedestrians who are currently forced to walk along the shoulder of this busy road; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Bluff City proposes to construct a sidewalk along Bluff City Highway between Town Hall and Bluff City Park to include four crosswalks with associated warning signage and flashing beacons at four key locations to create a safe route of passage for pedestrians.

**WHEREAS**, TDOT Multimodal Access funds can be used to provide the necessary funds to construct these facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the estimated cost of the project is \$745,286.50 with proposed funding of \$708,022.18 from Multimodal Access funds, and the remaining \$37,264.33 to be provided by the Town of Bluff City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Mayor and Alderman of the Town of Bluff City to submit an application for Multimodal Access funds.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor is authorized to enter into any and all necessary agreements and assurances to implement this application and project.
